In the last newsletter, we said the ninth fairway would be repaired during the summer. After more research and consultation with the University of Minnesota, Chris Fossen, our Grounds Superintendent, has revised the plan.

Over the summer, grounds crews will "verticut" the fairway in an attempt to reduce the tall fescue grass. After Labor Day, a new piece of equipment called an

AERA-vator will be used to aerate and seed the fairway. A drop area near the pines will be used during the fall. We ask for your patience while we work to improve this fairway!
